The progression of transvaginal sonographic findings in normal early first trimester pregnancies follows a highly predictable pattern, with a gestational age variability of approximately ± 0.5 week: gestational sac at 5.0 weeks, yolk sac at 5.5 weeks, embryo with heartbeat at 6.0 weeks, and amnion at 7.0 weeks.

Modern high-frequency ultrasound transducers make it possible to obtain detailed images of the early conceptus and its organs, and thus move part of the anatomy and anomaly scan from the second to the first trimester. Today, detection of embryonic and fetal structural abnormalities in the first trimester has frequently been reported.

Detection of structural abnormalities in the first ...

Ultrasound is then utilized during the first and second trimesters to establish the gestational age of the pregnancy and eventually to evaluate fetal anatomy. In the first trimester, pelvic ultrasound is employed to establish the presence or absence of an intrauterine gestational sac and to evaluate the viability of the pregnancy.

Role of ultrasound in the evaluation of first-trimester ...

In this study, we show that first trimester ultrasound can identify about half of all major fetal anomalies diagnosed antenatally (Table 6); in unselected and low risk pregnancies, about 40% of all antenatally diagnosed anomalies were identified at this stage in pregnancy. The detection rate for major fetal anomalies was higher (46%), with 45% of fetuses affected with one or more major malformation being identified.

Systematic review of first trimester ultrasound screening ...

We achieved a first trimester DR of 64% for major urinary abnormalities. All cases of persistent cloaca (1 of 1) and megacystis (6 of 6) were diagnosed in the first trimester. Bilateral renal agenesis (2 of 2), polycystic kidneys (1 of 1), and bilateral multicystic kidneys (1 of 1) were not detected at this stage of pregnancy.

What to expect from the first trimester ultrasound. Many women experience their first ultrasound between 11 to 14 weeks into their pregnancy. With this examination, also known as a "dating ultrasound," the doctor will evaluate gestational age and rule out or identify any major abnormalities in early development.

First-Trimester Screening. The First-Trimester Screening is an early optional non-invasive evaluation that combines a maternal blood screening test with an ultrasound evaluation of the fetus to identify risks for specific chromosomal abnormalities, including Down Syndrome Trisomy-21 and Trisomy-18. In addition to screening for these abnormalities, a portion of the test (known as the nuchal translucency) can assist in identifying other significant fetal abnormalities, such as cardiac disorders.
