Unleaded prices have levelled, from 114.5 p/litre last month to 114.5 p/litre now; Diesel prices have fallen from 118.2 p/litre to 117.8 p/litre; The price difference between diesel and unleaded has shrunk to 3.3 p/litre; National and Regional Petrol. Highest – London has recorded the highest price for unleaded at 115.7 p/litre.

From 1995 through 2006, the price difference among grades of gasoline was typically about 10¢ per gallon. Since 2006, the price difference among gasoline grades has generally increased. In 2019, the national annual average price of midgrade gasoline was about 40¢ per gallon more than regular-grade gasoline, and the average price for premium-grade gasoline was about 65¢ per gallon more than regular grade.
