Install the correct terminal end on the power lead wire and crimp it securely with a terminal multi-tool. Connect the power lead from the battery to the "BATT" terminal of the switch. Some ignition switches use a cross-tip screw to secure the wires, and some use spade clips on the wire ends.

1. Unscrew the bolts holding the coil in place using a wrench. Depending on the size of the ignition coil, it may be held on with anywhere from 1 to 4 bolts on most applications. Locate each bolt securing the coil in place and then use a socket of the appropriate size with a ratchet to loosen and remove the bolts.

Push the lock cylinder in so that the locking tab locks against the housing. Reinstall the trim panels you removed to access the lock cylinder.

Inside the ignition switch, several contacts connect vital electrical systems needed to start and run the car. Generally speaking, in the " OFF " position, the ignition switch doesn ' t connect anything; in the " ACC " position, the radio or fan may be energized; in the " RUN " position, the engine control module is energized; and finally, in the " START " position, the starter relay is engaged.

Compare the new ignition coil to the old ignition coil to ensure that both are the same design. Position the coil over the spark plug. Make sure the coil ' s mounting hole lines up with the stud or hole on the engine. Press down on the coil gently.

Before installing apply the dielectric grease inside the surface of the ignition coil. Doing this will help the ignition cable to prevent from sticking to the spark plugs. Now install the new ignition coil inside the cylinder. Screw the coil with bolts to secure them.

When installing under Ubuntu, Ignition starts automatically whenever the computer reboots. If you wish to stop this behavior, you need to use the update-rc.d tool to remove the service (uninstalling Ignition also removes the service) as follows: /etc/init.d/ignition stop update-rc.d -f ignition remove rm /etc/init.d/ignition When installing under other Linux distributions, use that ...
